

The 10th Teriological Conference, which took place in Warsaw on 13–14 February 2007, produced an interesting outcome. After a thorough selection 19 papers were approved for publication. These papers concern a variety of species (altogether some 17) with voles and European bison predominating (3 papers on each). When it comes to disciplines, almost 70% of papers were devoted to ecology, while the remaining 30% to conservation, genetics, and faunistics.
